The B's

- 10 Points awarded in this Bridge Center for club games
- 20 Someone who meets all the criteria with over 500 points is this.
- 30 A type of bid where one bids at the three level after a major suit bid by partner.
- 40 A double for penalty is said to be for this.
- 50 Bid made with moderate strength as the auction appears to be ending.

The C's

- 10 Taking all your tricks quickly is sometimes akin to money.
- 20 A way of leading that increases the usefulness of nines.
- 30 When your partner uses his chilly comment about a contract you will not be happy.
- 40 Like husbands and wives hands need to do this well to maximize trick-taking.
- 50 In a casino they would kick you out for doing this.

The D's

- 10 Indiana Jones would be good protection from this type of hand.
- 20 Playing a card to trick an opponent is this kind of play.
- 30 Leading a two off dummy the declarer played a six. Who am I?
- 40 A convention that “even” your kitty might think “odd”.
- 50 This kind of bid shows a singleton/void and support for your partner's bid suit.
