6. How do you indicate a 5-card suit with slam interest after the transfer?
7. How do you indicate a 6-card suit with invitational values after the transfer?
8. How do you indicate a 6-card suit with game values after the transfer?
9. How do you indicate a 6-card suit with slam interest after the transfer?
10. How do you ask for aces after a transfer?
11. What does a bid of another suit (or the same suit) mean after a transfer?
12. What is your method for bidding a hand with 5 of one major and 4 of the other?
13. What does 2S mean over 1NT?
14. What does 2NT mean over 1NT?
15. How does the 1NT bidder show a hand with 4 of the suit you transferred to?
16. How do you handle transfers if there is interference?
